A medical record transcriber (or transcriptionist), also known as an MT, is an allied health professional, who converts voice-recorded reports, as dictated by physicians and/or other healthcare professionals, into text format. It is the medical transcriptionist's responsibility to ensure the integrity and confidentiality of these reports.

- Medical transcription services range from small, one-person home-based businesses to sophisticated, high-tech corporations
- Many medical transcription services employ both on-site and home-based medical transcriptionists
- Medical transcriptionists can perform work in a hospital, doctor's office; or work from home

- Starting salary \$18,000 to \$33,000 a year

Industry Certifications

- Graduates are prepared and eligible to sit for the Association for Healthcare Documentation Integrity (AHDI) Registered Medical Transcriptionist (RMT) certification exam
- After two years of acute care (or equivalent) transcription experience, individuals may sit for the Certified Medical Transcriptionist (CMT) exam
